Other new features for Windows[®] include the Local Lock and Wipe feature which allows a data wipe even if the device is offline, controls for Web browsers and Microsoft[®] Office, and numerous new security-strenghening features. Also, as an optional service for iOS and AndroidTM, the device can connect to a company server or cloud service with programs such as a mail service or scheduling app, without leaving any data on the device itself. Finally, iOS 9, is supported with iOS 9 GM Seed support confirmed so iPhone and iPad users can experience secure Optimal Biz use with the newest OS.

The new features realize much more secure business use of laptop PCs and smart devices removing worry about security problems such as loss or theft.
